PART-A

KEY POINTS

KEY FACTS

- Gunotsav started in **2017**.
- 2025 is the **6th edition** of Gunotsav.
- Till date **more than 2 Cr students** and **1 Lakh External Evaluators** participated in it.
- Schools having **A+ Grade** have increased **from 11.56% in 2017 to 35.76 % in 2024**.
- Schools having **D Grade** have decreased from **14.54 % in 2017 to 0.8 % in 2024**.
- Based on Feedback of EE Govt has sanctioned **Rs 962 Cr under RIDF. ACR in 9,960 ; electrification in 35,314; Partition wall in 7,858** and **Boys toilets in 784** schools have been constructed.
- Now **training of the teachers** is customised based on the LO based results of Gunotsav.

GUNOTSAV 2025 : Nature of Evaluation (5/7)

- ◆ Evaluation will be for two days for each school: Self-Evaluation and External Evaluation
- ◆ **Self-Evaluation (only reading skill)** will be conducted by schools in presence of SMC/SMDC on the **1st day of Gunotsav.**
 - **100% students is to be evaluated on the day of Self-Evaluation**
- ◆ **External Evaluation** will be conducted on :
 - **Reading** (10% students)
 - **Writing** (All students)
 - **Numeracy/ Basic Mathematical Operations** (All students)
 - **Subject areas (MCQ)** (All students)

Gunotsav 2025: OMR sheet and Question Booklet (6/7)

◆ OMR Sheet

- Evaluation will be OMR based
- **For class I & II**, OMR sheets will be class-wise. **Teachers will fill up the circles** of the OMR sheet as per responses of the students as marked by students in their question booklet cum answer sheet
- **From class III onwards**, OMR sheet will be for individual child and **students will fill up the OMR sheet themselves**

◆ Question Booklet

- **Individual question papers** will be provided to each student (Class-I to IX)

GUNOTSAV 2025 : Online submission of School Evaluation Part (7/7)

- ◆ **The School Evaluation** (Co-scholastic, Community Participation and Infrastructure area) will be **online** like previous year.
- ◆ **School will submit** school evaluation part three days (03) before the day of External Evaluation through online mode
- ◆ On the day of External Evaluation, **External Evaluator will verify all indicators and descriptors of School Evaluation** as per record/observation/interaction with stakeholders **and edit (if required)**.

N:B: 10% mark will be added from School Evaluation part.


Hence, school Evaluation part of the respective school must be finally submitted by External Evaluators.

Gunotsav 2025 : NEW INCLUSION/ADDITION




- ◆ This year **Gunotsav Mobile App** (in addition to Gunotsav portal) has been developed. The app can be downloaded from **play store/App store** for submission of **Schools Evaluation areas** and **observation report of External Evaluators**.

- ◆ **Evaluation of Uniform** is included as separate evaluation area under Gunotsav as per directive of Hon'ble Chief Minister, Assam. The **External Evaluator will evaluate** different indicators/descriptors of uniform area on the day of External Evaluation and to be **submitted in the Gunotsav portal/App**.

- ◆ **Observation report of External Evaluator during Gunotsav 2024** is already displayed in the **Gunotsav Portal 2025**. The External Evaluator of Gunotsav 2025 **will examine whether action against said observation report has taken or not** and **views/comments** can be uploaded in this year's observation format

- ◆ **Transparency Award** : Aim is to conduct Gunotsav in **free, fair and transparent** manner. **District who shows more transparency in conduct of Gunotsav 2025 evaluation will be awarded with Transparency Award**



ROLE OF EXTERNAL EVALUATOR



ROLE OF EXTERNAL EVALUATOR (1/3)

Remain present in the assigned schools **from morning assembly till completion of the exercise** (upto labelling, packaging etc.)

1. Randomly check atleast **5/6 answer copies (each class)** of **Writing & Numeracy/ Basic Mathematical Operations** evaluated by teacher.
2. Tally the answers of the students and mark given by teacher in the OMR sheet.
3. Ensure that marks of said skills have been entered by teacher in the OMR sheet without any bias.

1. **Select 10% students randomly** of each class and will assess their **Reading Skill**.

2. **If** performance of the 10% children is found to be **more or less tallying with the performance** on the day of self evaluation, **will permit the school to entre marks of Reading Skill** (which was recorded in the prescribed format by teacher on the day of Self Evaluation) in OMR sheet.

3. **If major discrepancies** between performances of External Evaluation and Self Evaluation are found, **re-evaluation of all students of the class** will have to be done

ROLE OF EXTERNAL EVALUATOR (2/3)



Check the **seat arrangement**. Students of same class for classes –III to IX will **not sit in the same desk-bench**. The seat plan will be done by school as per seat plan enclosed in the Evaluation guidelines. However, packing of filled up OMR sheets will have to be done class wise carefully.



Monitor **smooth conduct of evaluation of subject areas** (Individual OMR Based Subject areas) and will take necessary **steps to avoid any malpractices, cheating etc.**



Move to each room during exam time and ensure smooth conduct of evaluation

- * **Sign the OMR sheet meant for External Evaluation**
 - * **Ensure sealing and proper packaging in front of you**

ROLE OF EXTERNAL EVALUATOR (3/3)

- **Verify** all indicators and descriptors of **School Evaluation part** and **edit** the areas of School Evaluation, if required and **upload** the final verified/edited School Evaluation part in the Gunotsav portal on the day of External Evaluation
- **Submit confidential observation report** online through Gunotsav Portal/App
- Will ensure presence of only **Head Teacher** and **Nodal Teacher** of parent school in the school on the day of External Evaluation. **No other teacher(s) of the parent school will be allowed to be present in the school on the day of External Evaluation.** The teacher of other school of the cluster will be deputed as invigilator for the school on the day of External Evaluation
- **Action taken by the school** on the confidential report of External Evaluator during Gunotsav 2024
- Check **uniform supplied** and submit views/comments in the portal/app as per Indicators & descriptors







SCHOLASTIC EVALUATION WILL BE ON : (1/6)

Skills (Class-II -IX)



Subjects (Class-I to IX)



There will be separate class wise frames (from class-II to IX) for Reading, Writing and Numeracy/Basic Mathematical Operations.

- **Reading assessment** : 3 Frames of pictures /words/ Sentences/Paragraphs.
- **Writing assessment** : 3 Frames of Picture/Topics. Marking will be as per 4 point rating scale (0, 1, 2, 3).
- **Numeracy/Basic Mathematical Operations** : Questions on number knowledge and its operations. Total 5 sub questions will be there (except class - II & IX; Four sub questions for class-II & IX) . Marking of each question will be done as per 3 point rating scale (0, 1,2).
- **Subject assessment** : On subject wise Learning Outcomes (MCQs)

Guideline for scoring (Skills) (3/6)

1. Reading - class II

3 Mark

- **All 3 words** are read correctly, confidently and fluently with proper pronunciation

2 Mark

- **2 words** are read correctly but takes time to associate letters with sounds.
- **Takes time to pronounce** the words
- **Takes time** to associate letters with sounds

1 Mark

- **1 word** is read
- **Takes time** to pronounce the words
- **Takes time** to associate letters with sounds

0 Mark

- **Could not read a single word**

Guideline for scoring of (Skills) (3/6)

2. Reading - class III to IX

3 Mark

- **All 3 sentences** are read correctly, confidently and fluently with proper pronunciation, pace and pause

2 Mark

- **2 sentences** are read
- **Takes time to pronounce** the words of the sentences.
- **Takes time to associate** letters with sounds

1 Mark

- **1 sentence** is read
- Takes time to pronounce the words of the sentences
- **Takes time to associate** letters with sounds

0 Mark

- **Could not read a single sentence correctly.**

3. Writing (4/6)

3 Point

- All **3 words/sentences** are on the topic.
- All 3 sentences are **written with grammatically correct** sentence structure.
- There **is no spelling error** in all 3 sentences.
- **Appropriate punctuation mark and capitalization** etc., are used in all 3 sentences.
- **Proper space between words** is maintained in the whole paragraph.

2 Point

- At least 2 word/sentences are on the topic.
- 2 sentences are **written with grammatically correct** sentence structure.
- **2-3 spelling errors in the whole paragraph.**
- **Occasionally, punctuation marks, capitalization etc.**, are not appropriately used but which is not affecting thecomprehensibility of the paragraph.
- Occasionally, **space between words is not properly maintained** but which is not affecting the comprehensibility of the paragraph.

1 Point

- At least 1 word/ sentence is on the topic
- Only 1 sentence is **written with grammatically correct** sentence structure.
- **4-6 spelling errors**
- **Frequent use of inappropriate punctuation marks, capitalization** etc., which is affecting the comprehensibility of the paragraph.
- **Space between words is frequently not maintained** which is affecting the comprehensibility of the paragraph.

0 Point

- The child has **not written anything**
- Not a single sentence is on the topic
- **The paragraph is not at all comprehensible** due to inappropriate sentence structure, spelling error, no space between words etc.

4. Numeracy/Basic Mathematical operations : (5/6)

2 POINT

- The child is **able to solve the problem completely correctly** following all necessary steps.

1 POINT

- If **the answer is not correct** though the **process/steps** of solving the question is **partially correct**

0 POINT

- If a child **does not attempt** to solve a problem, or,
- If a child is **not able to solve a question**

Subject Areas(MCQ) (6/6)

Subject Areas evaluation will be **on Learning Outcomes(LO) with competency base items.**



Question/Items will be **Multiple Choice**

For **Class-I&II**, there will be **two(02) options**



For **Class-III to IX**, there will be **four (04) options**

Class- VI & VII Maths & Science Questions are to be dual medium.

- **School will upload** filled up School Evaluation part in the Gunotsav Portal before three(03) days of conduct of External Evaluation.
- **External Evaluator will verify/edit (if any) as per observation/interaction/discussion** with SMC/MG/Teachers/Head/students **and verified/edited part to be uploaded in the portal/App on the day of External Evaluation .**



- ◆ **Visit your EE dashboard** for latest information
- ◆ **Update your profile information**
- ◆ Click on **forgot password** to reset your password
- ◆ For **helpdesk support** call or Mail on given details on website

Do's and Don'ts
for External Evaluators, Gunotsav 2025

Do's

- ◆ Will be **present** in the assigned schools **from morning assembly till completion** of the exercise (upto labelling, packaging etc.)
- ◆ Will **select 10% students randomly** of each class and will assess their **Reading Skill**
- ◆ Will **randomly check atleast 5/6 answer copies** (each class) of **Writing & Numeracy/ Basic Mathematical Operations** skills
- ◆ Will ensure that **marks of Reading, Writing & Numeracy/ Basic Mathematical Operations skills have been entered by teacher in the OMR sheet without any bias**
- ◆ Will thoroughly verify the indicators and descriptors of **School Evaluation** areas and will upload with modification, if any in the **Gunotsav portal/app** on the same day of External Evaluation
- ◆ Will thoroughly **observe the transparency of conduct of Evaluation** in the school and will submit the transparency report as per prescribed criteria in the portal/app
- ◆ Will **ensure presence of only Head Teacher and Nodal Teacher** of parent school in the school on the day of External Evaluation

Do's

- ◆ Will see the order copy of Invigilators /teachers of other schools to be present on the day of External Evaluation in the school
- ◆ Will ensure that the **seat plan is followed** as per seat plan enclosed in the Evaluation guidelines. However, packing of filled up OMR sheets will have to be done class wise carefully
- ◆ Will **move to each room** during MCQ (subject area) evaluation time and ensure smooth conduct of evaluation
- ◆ Will **take necessary steps to avoid any malpractices**, cheating etc. during subject areas evaluation
- ◆ Will ensure conduct of Evaluation as per prescribed Evaluation Schedule (Annexure-III of Evaluation Guidelines)
- ◆ Will **submit confidential observation report** online by login Gunotsav portal/app
- ◆ Will ensure **proper packeting of examination materials** which is to be done as per class wise
- ◆ Will fill up , **sign the OMR sheet** meant for External Evaluation and **will ensure sealing in front of him/her**
- ◆ Will **maintain impartiality and neutrality**

Don'ts

- ◆ **Will not allow any other teachers** except Head Teacher and Nodal Teacher to be present in the school on the day of External Evaluation. However, if any teacher comes for attendance in **Shiksa Setu App** will instruct to **leave the school campus (except Head Teacher and Nodal Teacher) immediately after attendance**
- ◆ Will **remove invigilator/teacher** from the school if he/she has been found to be involved in any malpractices or help the students to write answers
- ◆ Will **not allow** parents, **SMC/SMDC** and other community members to enter in the classrooms during Evaluation time
- ◆ Will **not allow** same class students to **seat in the same desk-bench**
- ◆ **Will not upload** School Evaluation area, Uniform area and confidential observation report in Gunotsav portal/app during Scholastic areas **Evaluation time**
